

Google Translate Client for Windows v1.1



A small "Green" (portable) Windows client capable of translating selected text from most Windows applications. Translation is obtained by making a web services call to the Google translate service.

This program does not offer any additional translation services; it just adds convenience by automating the translations process.

The translated text can be displayed as a ToolTip, a Tray Tip, pasted back into the original document (if you application will allow editing), or spoken via Text To Speech (requires Microsoft SAPI in the appropriate language to be installed on your system).

The application does not need to be installed, just download the executable and run it. It should run fine on Windows XP, Vista and 7. Internet access is obviously required. Just select text in any application, and press the hotkey (by default "CTRL Q").

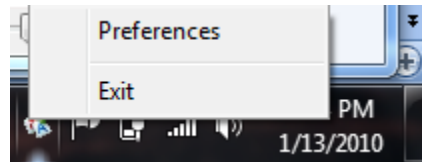

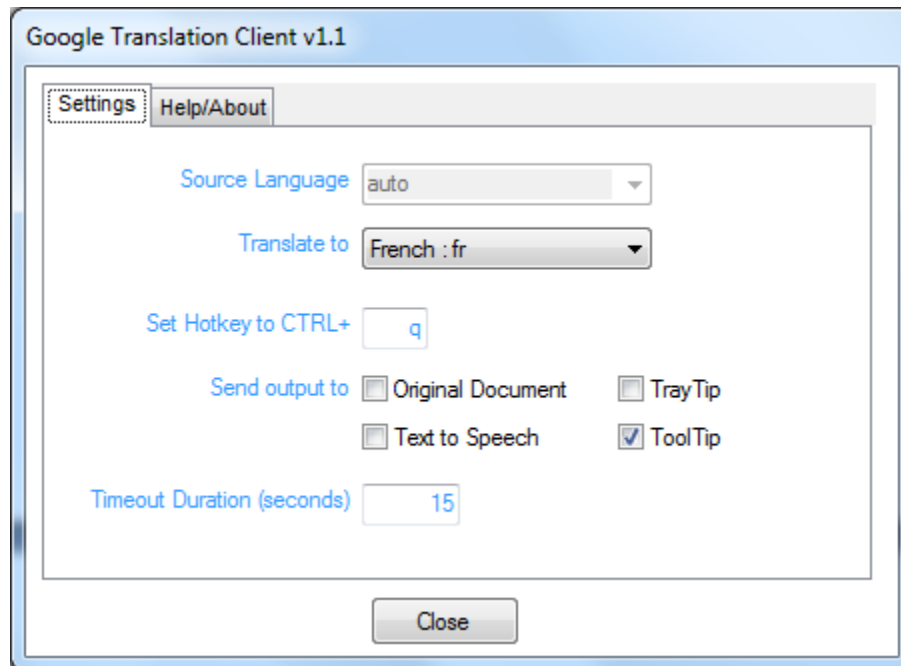
When the application is launched, it will simply display an icon in the right-hand side of the taskbar.



Simply click on the application icon to display the menu. There are only two options: "Preferences", and "exit".



The "Preferences" screen allows you to configure the following options:



The source language is set to "auto" for now. You can select the output options, and the timeout value (be careful, some display options are serial, the second option may not start until after the previous option has completed or reached the time-out value).

With the application running, go to the application where the source text needs to be translated, select the text you want to translate, and press "CTRL Q" for the translation to occur.

The settings will be saved in a file called "GoogleTranslate.dat". Keep this file in the same directory as the executable if you want to preserve your settings. If the file is deleted, a new file will be created the next time you change the preferences. Please note that the hotkey will NOT be active while the settings window is opened. Settings are automatically saved when you click on the "Close" button. The "Close" button does not close the application, just the preferences window.
